

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
Signing for the Provision of Financial Assistance to
Clean-Up the Tributaries of Imus River and Zapote River
OCTOBER 26, 2018

The City Government of Bacoor, through its City Mayor Lani Mercado-Revilla, and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources - Environmental Management Bureau CALABARZON Region, represented by Chief on Environmental Monitoring and Enforcement Division Engr. Jessie A. Conde, signed a MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) for the provision of Eight Million Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (P8,400,000.00) financial assistance to clean-up the tributaries of Imus River and Zapote River on October 26, 2018 at 1 pm at the Bacoor City Hall, Cavite.

The Memorandum of Agreement aims to strengthen the effort to comply with the mandates of the Supreme Court decision on Continuing Mandamus to clean, rehabilitate, and preserve Manila Bay.

The Department through the EMB proposes for the provision of funding assistance to the Local Government Units in Manila Bay Region. The City Government of Bacoor, on the other hand, have committed to share its responsibility for the clean-up of esteros, creeks and river tributaries of Zapote and Imus Rivers consistent with the goals and objectives of the Water Quality Management Area (WQMA) and the Operational Plan for Manila Bay Coastal Strategy (OPMBCS).
