

MOA Signing on Adopt an Estero/River Waterbody Program

Environmental Management Bureau 4A – RFM Corporation, James Hardie, Amkor Tech Inc. and City Government of Cabuyao, Laguna committed to support the protection, conservation and preservation of seven (7.0) km. stretch of NIA creek covering six (6) barangays of Cabuyao Laguna from Mamatid to Salang Langka River by joining the Adopt-an-Estero/River Water Body program thru a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signed on September 11, 2019 at the Cabuyao Municipal Hall. The MOA signing was attended by OIC-Regional Director Noemi A. Paranada, OIC-WQMA Girliesina Sebarillo, Mayor Mel Gecolea, Councilor Fe Humarang, Councilor Cocoy Lopez, Chief Environmental Police Erwin BT Epol, CDRRMO Rudy Darez, Barangay Chairmans Emerson Devoma and Armando Amoranto. The MOA signing signals the start of a promising and meaningful collaboration that can only lead to one thing: “To save, clean and protect our waterways toward the sustainable existence.” The Adopt-an-Estero Program is one of the priority programs of the DENR and a key strategy to address the continuing mandamus of the Supreme Court to several government agencies to clean-up Manila Bay and its tributaries.
