

Incentives for LGUs on Upgrading the EMB-Funded Materials Recovery Facilities

Since 2012 up to 2019, a total of PhP 55 million have been downloaded by EMB CALABARZON for the establishment of Materials Recovery Facilities (MRF) to Local Government Units (LGUs). This is to support them on their solid waste management programs mandated by the RA 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000.

For 2021, EMB recognized selected 11 LGUs on their continuous active participation on operating their existing EMB-funded MRFs. A total of PhP 1,650,000 (PhP 150k each) was downloaded to these LGUs to serve as an incentive and to upgrade the said existing facilities.

Provision of Solid Waste Management Equipment to Local Government Units (LGUs)

This year, 2021, EMB recognized the need of giving technical assistance on RA 9003, specifically on increasing waste diversion. Based on study, bulk of the solid waste generation of LGUs are biodegradable wastes. Upon management of the said wastes, less wastes will be disposed to sanitary landfills, resulting to increasing the lifespan of the said facilities.

A total of PhP 10 million was downloaded to EMB CALABARZON by the Central Office for the provision of solid waste management equipment to selected 10 LGUs. A set of composters and biodegradable waste shredding machines to produce composts / soil conditioners were downloaded to LGUs to help them manage biodegradable wastes.
