



Environmental Management Bureau – CALABARZON Region celebrated the 2022 National Clean Up Month and International Coastal Clean Up Weekend with themes “Reimaginig a Clean, Healthy, Sustainable and Trash Free Seas” and “Trash Free Seas: Ending the flow of Trash at the Source” by spearheading an orchestrated clean up activity on September 17, 2022 at the coastal area of Brgy. Timalan-Balsahan, Bucana Malaki, Naic, Cavite. A total of 1,891.5 kilograms of solid waste was collected from the stretch of 1,000 meters shoreline segregated according to their types: Residual wastes- 567.45 kilograms; Recyclable wastes- 189.15 kilograms; Biodegradable wastes – 945.75 kilograms; and Special waste- 189.15 kilograms. The success of the activities was carried out by the collective efforts from DENR-EMB CALABARZON Region, PEMU-Cavite, River Warriors, MENRO Naic, Barangay officials of Naic, Bureau of Jail Management Phenology -Naic, Philippine National Police -Naic, MSP Eagles Club, Samahan ng Mangingisda, Talaba Farmers, 4p's Members, PG-ENRO Cavite, DENR-PENRO Cavite, Department of Interior and Local Government of Cavite, Bureau of Fire Protection, Residents of the Barangay Timalan-Balsahan, Residents of the Barangay Bucana Malaki, and Ocean Save Organization. Collected solid wastes were loaded in a truck and further hauled by Solid Waste Management Office of Naic and Philippine Ecology Navotas Sanitary Landfill for its final disposal. It was followed by a seminar on Bokashi making at the Brgy. Timalasan-Balsahan covered court and throwing of bokashi balls at the Timalan River.
